Sunshine Room 0-2 years



- The sunshine room is a place where babies feel safe and secure, they have opportunities to explore their environment, under the care and supervision from their key person.
- The Sunshine room cares for babies ages between 0-2 years. Daily creative activities are carried out and are differentiated to meet individual needs.
- Within the room there is a cosy area and a black and white area and sand and water play. By providing these opportunities we are enabling growth and development in all the babies we care for.
- To maintain parent partnership daily record books are completed to exchange information about your babies day at nursery.

Rainbow Room 2-3 years



- The rainbow Room is a large space for children to explore and investigate their learning environment freely.
- All toys and equipment are accessible to the children.
- The room is divided into areas such as role play, construction, investigation, creative, sand, water and book area .
- The role of the key person is to plan and deliver daily focused activities, this is to enhance children's development and provide learning opportunities based on children's interests.

Little Star's Room 3-4 years



- The Little Stars Room is place for children to learn, build confidence and to develop independent skills.
- The room is divided into areas such as role play, construction, investigation, creative, sand, water and book area .
- A Friendship Island Lodge is a space available for children to sit and relax with a book and for staff to carry out circle time activities.
- The pre-school room provides opportunities for children to learn and develop their own interests in activities throughout the day.
- The children's key person role is to plan focused activities based on the children's interests to further develop their skills.
- At meal times the children are encouraged to help set up and serve their own meals under the supervision of staff.

Early Years Foundation Stage



- What is the Early Years Foundation Stage? Welcome to the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS), which is how the Government and early years professionals describe the time in your child's life between birth and age 5.
- This is a very important stage as it helps your child get ready for school as well as preparing them for their future learning and successes.
- From when your child is born up until the age of 5, their early years experience should be happy, active, exciting, fun and secure; and support their development, care and learning needs.
- Nurseries, pre-schools, reception classes and childminders registered to deliver the EYFS must follow a legal document called the Early Years Foundation Stage.

Early Years Foundation Stage



- It sets out:
- The legal welfare requirements that everyone registered to look after children must follow to keep your child safe and promote their welfare
- The 7 areas of learning and development which guide professionals' engagement with your child's play and activities as they learn new skills and knowledge
- Assessments that will tell you about your child's progress through the EYFS
- Expected levels that your child should reach at age 5, usually the end of the reception year; these expectations are called the "Early Learning Goals (ELGs)" There is also guidance for the professionals supporting your child on planning the learning activities, and observing and assessing what and how your child is learning and developing.

Healthy eating



- We have been awarded the Golden Apple Award.

- Milk is offered at snack times and children have access to fresh water throughout the day.
- We have a 4 weekly summer and winter menus.
- All allergies and dietary requirements are catered for.

- Snack time children have a choice of vegetable crudities, fruit and savoury snacks.
- An example of the dinner and tea offered to children is penne pasta with a tomato sauce, garlic bread and for dessert fruit yogurts. For tea cheese sandwiches with cherry tomatoes and melon.
